Comparison between Cyprus and United Kingdom Citizenship Programs

Anyone who is planning to live, work and study in the UK is required to have a visa in order to stay in the country for an extended period of time.

Immigration requirements for England (and the United Kingdom as a whole) are determined by your nationality and the country(ies) that you have citizenship in.

Since immigrants are finding it harder and harder to obtain a British passport, this comparison table will focus on the reasons why applying for the EU Cyprus citizenship investor visa provides easier access to the UK.
